

GUESTHOUSE AND BED AND BREAKFAST OCCUPANCY SURVEY

MONTHLY REPORT – FEBRUARY 2005

Average room occupancy in guesthouse and bed and breakfast establishments for February was 21%, the same level recorded for February 2004. Average bed-space occupancy was also unchanged with last year's level of 15%. This represents a gross estimate of 20,300 bedrooms and 32,600 bed-spaces sold during February 2005, decreases of 10% and 9% respectively on February 2004.

By Type

Average room occupancy in guesthouses was 24%, down 1 percentage point on February 2004. Bed and breakfast establishments recorded an increase of 1 percentage point to give a room occupancy of 20%.

Visitor content in guesthouses increased by 9 percentage points from 41% to 50%. Visitor content in bed and breakfast establishments was 65%, a drop of 11 percentage points on the 2004 level.

By Region

Only the North West area of Northern Ireland was able to show an increase in average room occupancy on February 2004, up 3 percentage points to record a level of 18%. The North East, South West and South East areas showed decreases of 2, 1 and 1 percentage points to give room occupancy levels of 21%, 13% and 21% respectively. The limited return for the Belfast region was too small to ensure accurate occupancy statistics.

By Price

Guesthouse and bed and breakfast establishments in the £20-£29.99 price range experienced an increase of 3 percentage points to give a room occupancy level of 21%. Establishments in other price ranges experienced decreases in room occupancy.

SAMPLE SIZE IN FEBRUARY WAS 152 GUESTHOUSE AND BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENTS WITH 657 BEDROOMS AND 1,558 BED-SPACES. EXCLUDING UNIVERSITY AND COLLEGE STOCK, IN FEBRUARY 2005 NORTHERN IRELAND GUESTHOUSE AND BED AND BREAKFAST STOCK COMPRISED OF 796 ESTABLISHMENTS WITH 3,460 BEDROOMS AND 7,760 BED-SPACES.
