# Getting there

## Car

Belfast Waterfront is located in Lanyon Place, just off Oxford Street in Belfast city centre.

If you are travelling on a major road into the city, follow signs for the city centre and Belfast Waterfront via East Bridge Street or Oxford Street.

## Car Parking

The multi-storey Lanyon Place car park is located 100 metres from the venue. The car park at the Belfast Hilton Hotel is also multi-storey and is next door to the building. The current hourly rate for the car parks in Lanyon Place and the Belfast Hilton Hotel is £2.50.

## Bus

### From Derry~Londonderry

Goldline: From Derry~Londonderry Bus Centre, take the 212 service to Belfast Europa Bus Centre. Services run every half hour throughout the day.

### From Dublin

Bus Éireann: From Dublin Busáras, take the X1 service to Belfast Europa Bus Centre. Services run on the hour.

### From Cork

Bus Éireann: From Cork Parnell Place Bus Station take the X8 towards Dublin Airport, then from Dublin Airport take the X1 service to Belfast Europa Bus Centre. From Cork, the X8 service departs every 2 hours.

### From Galway

Bus Éireann: From Galway Bus Station take the X20 towards Dublin Airport, then from Dublin Airport take the X1 service to Belfast Europa Bus Centre. The X20 departs every hour on the half hour.

### From Limerick (Bus Station)

Bus Éireann: Take the X12 service to Dublin Airport, then from Dublin Airport take the X1 service to Belfast Europa Bus Centre. The X12 departs every 2 hours.

### From Dublin Airport

Bus Éireann: The X1 service departs on the hour.

## Train

### From Derry~Londonderry

NI Railways: From Derry~Londonderry Train Station, take the No. 3 service to Belfast Central Station. Trains depart every 2 hours.

### From Dublin

From Dublin Connolly Station, take the Enterprise to Belfast Central Station. The Enterprise departs regularly from Dublin Connolly Station.

### From Cork

From Cork Kent Station, take the train to Dublin Heuston Station. From there, take the connecting Luas to Dublin Connolly Station and then the Enterprise to Belfast Central Station.

### From Galway

From Galway Ceannt Station, take the train to Dublin Heuston Station. From there, take the connecting Luas to Dublin Connolly Station and then the Enterprise to Belfast Central Station.

### From Limerick

From Limerick Colbert Station, take the train to Dublin Heuston Station. From there, take the connecting Luas to Dublin Connolly Station and then the Enterprise to Belfast Central Station.
